WHO WE ARE

DNA Nexus Distribution is an import and distribution company based in New Cairo, Egypt. We represent international manufacturers in the Egyptian market and sell their products through our own commercial network. Our first business line is medical, aesthetic and regenerative technology, distributed nationwide for European, Asian and American brands. Our agro line applies the same infrastructure to bulk grains and oilseeds.

WHAT WE DO FOR A SUPPLIER

We are the counterparty on the Egyptian side. You ship; we take the cargo from the vessel to the buyer and we secure the payment.

HOW IT WORKS

- 01 Port & inspection:** delivery at the discharge port, inspection, sampling and weighing with the appointed surveyors.
- 02 Customs & licensing:** import licensing held in house; customs, GOEIC import control, agricultural quarantine and NFSA food-safety documentation managed by our team.
- 03 Storage or direct delivery:** discharge straight to the buyer's trucks, or storage arranged through partner facilities.
- 04 B2B distribution:** placement with flour mills, feed producers, oil crushers and food manufacturers, serving private and public sector buyers.
- 05 Secured payment:** transactions structured on documentary terms, with payments secured through confirmed letters of credit.

WHAT WE TRADE

Milling wheat • Corn (feed, food and industrial grades) • Sunflower oil • Soybeans • Other grains and oilseeds on request.

WHY EGYPT

Egypt is one of the largest wheat importers in the world, with structural demand driven by a growing population, a milling industry built on imported grain, and a feed sector supplied from abroad. It is also a natural gateway to the wider region.

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WHAT WE RUN

Contract, banking, freight, port, customs, documents: each runs on its own clock, and a slip in any one of them shows up in the rest. We hold them together, so you keep one counterparty from the contract to final delivery.



CONTRACTING



We negotiate and sign the purchase contract: price, quantity, commercial terms, payment conditions. Then we prepare the invoice, the packing list and the certificates of origin and quality, and check them against it.

BANKING



Documentary letters of credit and collections, letters of guarantee, transfers: we arrange the instrument and follow the presentation. A bank rejects on a detail, so we read the credit line by line against the contract.

OCEAN FREIGHT



We book with the carrier when the freight is ours, and follow your booking when it is not. Bills of lading, delivery orders and arrival notices pass through us, corrections included. We also handle container returns when cargo moves that way.

PORT & INLAND



We schedule port handling, unloading, storage and inland transport. Demurrage, detention and port storage are the cost of a slow shipment, and we watch the clock on every leg.

CUSTOMS



We run the clearance and follow the file through inspection, valuation, tariff classification, duties, permits and release. The tariff line and the customs value decide the duty, and when customs comes back for more, we answer.

DOCUMENT CONTROL



Commercial, banking and shipping documents have to say the same thing, line by line: description, quantity, value, the numbers on the bill of lading. We read them against each other and catch a mismatch while it is still a correction.
